

Digital Healthcare Entrepreneurship School in February 2024.

Within the framework of the Upper Rhine university alliance *Eucor - The European Campus*, the renowned Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) in cooperation with the University of Basel and the University of Strasbourg invites students from all Eucor universities to participate in a Winter School on *Digital Healthcare Entrepreneurship.* The Winter School is designed as a one-week block course and allows students to work on exciting current issues at the intersection of healthcare, digitalization and entrepreneurship. Participating students earn 3 ECTS credits for their studies at the Winter School. The interdisciplinary and international teams are accompanied by lecturers from science and practice. In addition to students from the five Eucor universities, participation is also open to students from the European University Alliance EPICUR. The Winter School

The *Digital Healthcare Entrepreneurship School* brings together students from several European universities to spend a week deepening their knowledge of digital healthcare entrepreneurship. Students gain experience in entrepreneurship and learn how to obtain the resources necessary to implement a product vision. The Winter School teaches entrepreneurial skills that are critical to launching a successful business. The primary focus is on digital businesses in the healthcare industry. A deep understanding of how healthcare works and current healthcare necessities is critical to identifying entrepreneurial potential. The goals of the Winter School are to identify potential business ideas that offer added value for patients and physicians, to develop a viable business model for this purpose, and to present this successfully in front of financiers or a jury of experts.

The one week-long program is hosted by the renowned Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) and supported by Eucor partners University of Basel and University of Strasbourg. It is embedded in a series of social activities to promote exchange among participants.
