

Spring School Sustainable Entrepreneurship in April 2024.

Within the framework of the European University Alliance *EPICUR*, the renowned University of Natural Resources and Life Science, Vienna (BOKU) in cooperation with the University of Basel and the University of Strasbourg invites students to participate in a Spring School on *Sustainable Entrepreneurship*. The Spring School is designed as a one-week block course and allows students to work on exciting current issues at the intersection of sustainability, innovation and entrepreneurship. Participating students earn 3 ECTS credits for their studies at the Spring School. The interdisciplinary and international teams are accompanied by lecturers from science and practice. In addition to students from Basel and Vienna, participation is also open to students all 9 EPICUR-Universities. An overview of the participating universities can be found here.
