

- 20 participating students from Switzerland, France and Germany


RESULTS

Innovation of the Course through Student Ownership Establishment of the *Tri-National Council* which fostered regular intercultural exchange by regularly facilitating exchange in diverse group settings, always including at least one student from each participating university.



- Bachelor & Master students from different disciplines
- Daily sessions from 9am to 5pm
- Joint virtual space & decentral on-site learning rooms
- Key deliverable: SDG Walks city explorations with a focus on sustainability
- Goal: To create an open, intercultural & student oriented learning space

DIDACTIC APPROACH

Inspired by Integrated Problem-Solving Competencies Approach by Wiek et al. (2011). Some examples of how different competencies were required throughout the course:

- Intercultural Competency: Discussing adequate solutions for different social, cultural, economic & political contexts
